Thomas Edison was born in Ohio, U.S.A., in 1847. He didn't go to school. His mother taught him at home. Edison was very smart and he liked reading. He was very interested in science and he was always trying to find out how things worked.
Edison moved to New York when he was 22. To begin with, he didn't have any money, but he was very good at fixing machines, so he soon found work. Soon after, he invented his first machine. He was paid a lot of money for his invention, so he built a laboratory. He found a team of people to work for him and do lots of experiments on lots of different things.

During the late 1870s, Edison and his team worked very hard and Edison invented several new machines. In 1877, he invented the first machine which could record sound. Then he decided to invent an electric light. Edison wanted to make a light bulb that could work for a long time. He succeeded on October 22, 1879.
