"Thank you," said the man. So the boys filled the pails and the man poured the water on the fire.


A short while later the fisherman and his friends arrived in more boats. They climbed on board the ship and put the fire out.

Edison moved to New York when he was 22. To begin with, he didn't have any money, but he was very good at fixing machines, so he soon found work. Soon after, he invented his first machine. He was paid a lot of money for his invention, so he built a laboratory. He found a team of people to work for him and do lots of experiments on lots of different things.

During the late 1870s, Edison and his team worked very hard and Edison invented several new machines. In 1877, he invented the first machine which could record sound. 
